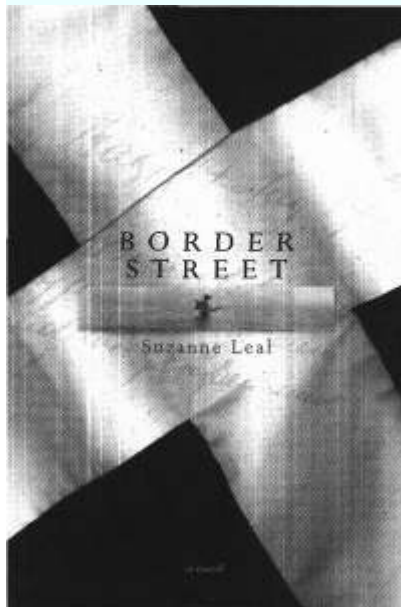

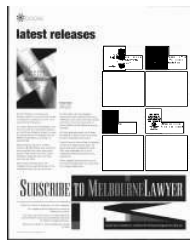
Kate's inquisitiveness about her neighbours soon gets the better of her and before long, the young woman

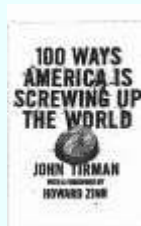
